

Kenersys opens wind turbine plant in Baramati

WIND turbine manufacturer Kenersys, part of the Kalyani Group, has inaugurated its manufacturing plant for multi-megawatt on-shore wind turbines in Baramati. The facility was inaugurated by Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar in the presence of BN Kalyani, chairman, Kenersys Group and chairman and managing director, Bharat Forge Ltd.

Amit Kalyani, director, Kenersys Group and executive director of Bharat Forge Ltd, Paulo Fernando Soares, global chief executive officer (CEO) K Kenersys Group and Kailash Tarachandani, CEO, Kenersys India, were among those present.

The Baramati plant has been set up on an area of 35 acres and a built up area of 5,600 sqm and it will manufacture hundreds of wind turbines of KENERSYS type K82 2.0MW with 82 m rotor diameter and a total height of 140 meters, said a company statement.

Synerdrive technology comprises an advanced cooling system for the harsh climate conditions and a special converter system that keeps the turbine in an idling mode during a grid down-time, he added.
